GENERAL INFORMATION

MANILLA HERITAGE MUSEUM incorporates the Royce Cottage Collection and the Manilla Community Archives.

The Museum is managed by Manilla Historical Society Inc.

The Collection is housed in the former family home of engineer G.H.Royce, whose company constructed the iron bridge over the Namoi River at Manilla (1884-86). The Museum comprises a General Reference Room, Environmental and Feature Displays, the Yarramanbully Schoolhouse and a Memorial Garden honouring the Chinese contribution to Manilla's progress. Archive documents available for research include collected Manilla Community Histories, contributed Family Histories and the compilation, "Manilla's Lost Folks" & its accompanying files (1883-2007).

Manilla's FAMILY HISTORY RESOURCES

a) "MANILLA'S LOST FOLKS"

is kept in the Family History section of the Reference Room and is the Museum's primary family history resource. It lists information available in public records and documents and is regularly updated by author Shirley Coote.

The book is available for sale from the Museum (see below) and is republished every 2 years - post-print additional entries are provided to purchasers in supplementary pages. Leave address details with staff.
